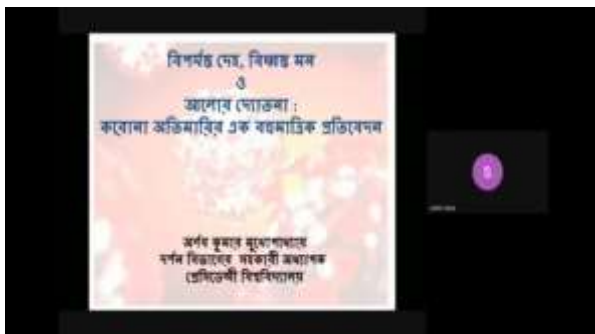

On 14th September, 2020, the Department of Philosophy hosted a webinar featuring Dr. Arnab

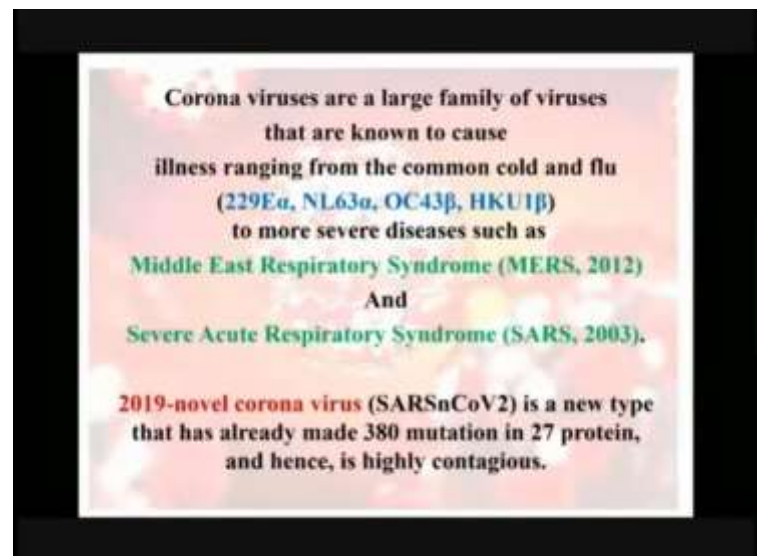
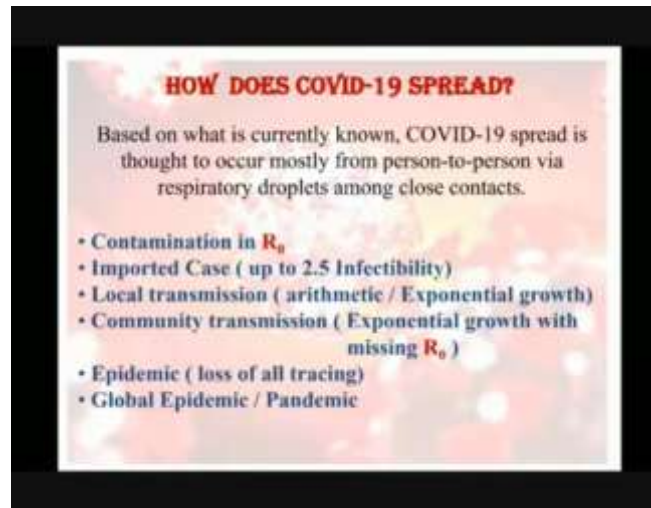


Kumar Mukhopadhyay, who provided an insightful talk on the COVID-19 pandemic from a philosophical perspective. The webinar was attended by students, faculty, and guests interested in exploring the deeper implications of the pandemic beyond its immediate

health and economic impacts. Dr.



Mukhopadhyay began by situating the COVID-19 pandemic within the broader historical and philosophical context of pandemics. He referenced historical pandemics, such as the Black Death and the Spanish flu, highlighting how societies have historically responded to such crises. Dr. Mukhopadhyay analyzed how the pandemic disrupted social structures and norms. He spoke about the changes in work, education, and interpersonal relationships, and how these changes might lead to a reevaluation of societal values and priorities. He was also talking about that the significance of Philosophy. He stated that further, in order to fight this battle with hope,





we need to carry on with the deductive logical structure for ensuring a certainty of win, at the same time we need to be careful the premises whose truth are determined by inductive methods.
