

Outline of CBCS . . .

- Elective Course: Generally a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses
 and which may be very specific or specialized or advanced or supportive to the
 discipline/subject of study or which enables an exposure to some other
 discipline/subject/domain or nurtures the candidate's proficiency/skill.
- 2.1 <u>Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Course</u>: Elective courses may be offered by the main discipline/subject of study is referred to as Discipline Specific Elective. The University/Institute may also offer discipline related Elective courses of interdisciplinary nature (to be offered by main discipline/subject of study).
- 2.2 Dissertation/Project: An elective course designed to acquire special/advanced knowledge, such as supplement study/support study to a project work, and a candidate studies such a course on his own with an advisory support by a teacher/faculty member is called dissertation/project.
